BY THE COMMISSION.

O R D E R

J. W. YOUNG has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by him of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers between Chico and Willows.

A public hearing on this application was conducted by Examiner Handford at Chico on February 17, 1920, the matter was duly submitted and is now ready for decision.

Applicant proposes to charge rates in accordance with a schedule marked Exhibit "A" and attached to the application in this proceeding; to operate on a schedule of 1-round trip daily, serving the intermediate communities at Hamilton City and Orland; using as equipment one Hudson 7-passenger capacity automobile.

Applicant proposes to succeed to the business of E. P. Chrissinger, who is now and has for some years, operated an automobile stage line over the route herein sought. Mr. Chrissinger now desires to retire from the business of a common carrier and applicant herein proposes to render the service over the route herein sought. There is no transfer of either operative rights or equipment contemplated as between the operator, Chrissinger, and the applicant herein.

At the hearing on this application there was no appearance protesting the granting of same and as the proposed service is a continuation of that heretofore rendered by Mr. Chrissinger, who desires to withdraw from the business, the application should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by J. W. Young of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers between Chico and Willows and intermediate points; provided, however, that the rights and privileges hereby granted may not be transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such transfer or assignment has first been secured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicle may be operated under this certificate unless such vehicle is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by such applicant under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory
