ORDER

Pearl Rolison, Elizabeth Bass, Bertha F. Johnstone, Clara Archer, E. A. Rolison, and Orr M. Chenoweth having filed with the Railroad Commission an application for authority to convey to Ida F. Bass their interests in certain telephone lines formerly owned and operated in Shasta County, California, by Herbert Bass, deceased, and by Redding, Ingot and Wengler Telephone Company, a corporation, in accordance with the terms of three bills of sale, copies of which are attached to said application and marked Exhibits "C" and "D", and as set forth in a Decree of Distribution made and entered in the Superior Court of Shasta County on March 14, 1919, a copy of which Decree is attached to said application and marked Exhibit "A", and as set forth in an Order of Dissolution made and entered in said Superior Court on December 24, 1919, a copy of which Order is attached to said application and marked Exhibit "B"; and it appearing to this Commission that this is not a case

requiring a public hearing and that this application should be granted,
