FOURTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission by Decision Number 6864, dated November 24, 1919, as amended from time to time, authorized applicant to issue and sell \$7,500,000.00 of bonds at not less than 91 per cent of their face value plus accrued interest and expend \$5,829,373.75 of the proceeds; and

WHEREAS, applicant reports that during January 1920, it has expended for new construction the sum of \$1,010,659.11, as set forth in the statement attached to the Fourth Supplemental Petition in the above entitled matter and therefore asks permission to withdraw from the special fund created as a result of the sale of said \$7,500,000.00 of bonds, the sum of \$630,209.34, and the Commission being of the opinion that applicant's request should be granted as herein provided;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY be, and it is hereby, granted authority to withdraw \$630,209.34 from the special trust fund created through, and as a result of, the sale of \$7,500,000.00 of bonds, the issue of which was authorized by Decision Number 6864, dated November 24, 1919, to pay

for and finance in part the cost of the properties set forth in the statement attached to the Fourth Supplemental Petition in the above entitled matter.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision Number 6864, dated November 24, 1919, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this Fourth Supplemental Order.
