ORDER

Eddie Webb has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by him of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers, freight and express between Varain and Coulterville, and Coulterville and Kinsley.

Applicant proposes to charge rates in accordance with a schedule marked Exhibit "A" and filed with the Application in this proceeding and operate on a schedule of one round trip daily between Varain and Coulterville and tri-weekly between Coulterville and Kinsley, using as equipment one three passenger Ford automobile twenty-two horse power, licensed by State Motor Vehicle Department under license number 210-579 and one Pierce automobile five passenger thirty-six horse power, licensed by State Motor

Vehicle Department under license number 412-734, during the months in which automobile transportation is possible and to operate wagons during the winter months when the use of an automobile is impracticable.

Applicant is the possessor of a United States Mail contract over the route herein sought, and desires authority to haul passengers, freight and express in connection with the United States Mail, there being no other regular method of transportation available for the public, and we are of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by EDDIE WEBB of an automobile stage as a common carrier of passengers, freight and express between Varain and Coulterville and Coulterville and Kinsley;

PROVIDED, however, that the rights and privileges hereby granted may not be transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such transfer or assignment has first been secured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicle may be operated under this certificate unless such vehicle is owned by the

applicant herein or is leased by such applicant on a contract
or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
