O R D E R

IT APPEARING from the verified application of Garden Grove City Water Company that the lot hereinafter described with the pumping plant thereon is not now used and useful and was not used during the year 1919 and that the service of applicant was not impaired thereby, and it appearing to the Commission that a public hearing on said application is not necessary,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Garden Grove City Water Company be and it is hereby authorized and empowered to hereafter transfer for a consideration of \$456 the property described as follows, to-wit:

The south seventy-four feet (74') of lot four (4) in Block "A" of Cook's Addition to Garden Grove, in the County of Orange, State of California, as per map recorded in Book 8, page 9, Miscellaneous Maps, records of Orange County, California; together with the well, tank, engine, pumping plant and pumping equipment upon said premises,

which said property it is hereby found is not necessary or useful

in the performance of its duties to the public.
