C. E. Sansome has petitioned the Railroad Commission for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an automobile passenger and express service between Taft and Hays Lease, Section 36, Elk Hills, Kern County and intermediate points, a distance of 14 miles.

There being no means of transportation between Taft and Hays Lease except private conveyances, the public would no doubt be benefitted by such a passenger and freight service as proposed.

We are of the opinion that this is not a matter on which a public hearing should be held and that the application should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by C. E.
