Oakland-Newark Auto Stage Line having made application for permission to abandon operation of an automobile stage service as a common carrier of passengers between Centerville and Newark for the reason that the receipts from operation do not equal the expense of operation and that a thorough trial of the operations over a period of thirteen months has resulted in a deficit, and at times three or four days would elapse without a passenger applying for transportation and the Commission being fully advised and of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted;
