Nelson has petitioned the Railroad Commission to issue to him a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the operation of an automobile passenger stage line between Southern Pacific Depot at Palo Alto and the U.S. Public Health Service Station, located a short distance outside the city limits of Palo Alto.

There being no means of transportation except a more or less expensive taxicab service and it being apparent that public convenience and necessity require the operation of such a passenger stage service and, further, that we are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary, the application is hereby granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

1-- That the applicant, R. M. Nelson, file immediately with the Railroad Commission time schedule and tariffs setting forth rates, fares and charges in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.

2-- That the rights and privileges hereby authorized may not again be leased, transferred or assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such lease, transfer or assignment has first been secured.

3-- No vehicle may be operated under this authority by the applicant, R. M. Nelson, unless such vehicle is owned by such applicant or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
