ORDER

Palmdale Water Company owns and operates a public utility water system and supplies water for irrigation purposes to consumers in the vicinity of Palmdale, Los Angeles County, California. In the above entitled matter said company makes application to the Railroad Commission for authority to sell said water system to Littlerock Creek Irrigation District and Palmdale Irrigation District, municipal corporations, and said municipal corporations have joined in the application herein, in accordance with the terms of a certain agreement, copy of which is attached to said application and made a part thereof; and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be, and the same is hereby granted, on the following conditions:

1. That on or before June 30, 1920, Palmdale Water Company shall file with the Railroad Commission a certified copy of a definite and detailed description of all of the properties.

2. That within ten (10) days of the time when Palmdale Water Company actually relinquishes possession and control of its public utility water system and transfers same as herein authorized, a certified statement shall be filed with the Railroad Commission by said company, indicating the date upon which such transfer became effective.
