In the Matter of the Application of HORACE NELSON, STOCKHOLDERS AUXILIARY CORPORATION, a corporation, and APANOLIO WATER COMPANY, a dissolved corporation, for permission for the said Stockholders Auxiliary Corporation, a corporation, and said Apanolio Water Company, a dissolved corporation, to sell their interests in the Half Moon Bay Water Company to said Horace Nelson.

ORDER

Stockholders Auxiliary Corporation, a corporation, which owns a 6/15 interest, and Apanolio Water Company, a dissolved corporation, whose Board of Directors acting as Trustees, owns a 4/15 interest in Half Moon Bay Water Company, a co-partnership, having applied to the Railroad Commission for permission to sell their interest for \$1000.00 and \$666.66, respectively, to Horace Nelson, and Horace Nelson having joined in the application and having reported that he and Wm. Meisner, who owns a 5/15 interest in Half Moon Bay Water Company, intend to combine their interests in the water company and make all necessary improvements;

And the Commission being of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary, and that the application should be granted,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Stockholders Auxiliary Corporation and Apanolio Water Company be and they are

hereby authorized to sell their respective interests in Half Moon Bay Water Company described in the petition herein to Horace Nelson.

The authority herein granted is subject to the following conditions:

1. The price paid by Horace Nelson for the properties referred to in this petition shall never be urged by him, his successors or assigns, before this Commission as a measure of value of said properties for rate fixing or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

2. Within thirty (30) days after the execution of the deed or bill of sale, Horace Nelson shall file with the Railroad Commission a certified copy of such deed or bill of sale.

3. The authority herein granted will apply only to such sale as may be made on or before October 1, 1920.
