O R D E R

Phil Dicke, J. P. Hildreth and G. E. Skillicorn have petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order approving the sale and transfer of certain operative rights for the conduct of a motor freight service between Healdsburg and Santa Rosa, Sonoma County, California. Phil Dicke, doing business under the fictitious name of the Healdsburg and Santa Rosa Auto Freight Company, now operating the service, desires to sell a four-fifths interest in said truck line, and applicants, J. P. Hildreth and G. E. Skillicorn, desire to purchase a four-fifths interest in said truck line and to continue operations as a co-partnership consisting of applicants, Dicke, Hildreth and Skillicorn and do business under the fictitious name of the Healdsburg and Santa Rosa Auto Freight Company.

The rights and privileges proposed to be transferred are those acquired by applicant, Phil Dicke, operating under the fictitious name of the Healdsburg and Santa Rosa Auto Freight Company, by reason of the decision of the Railroad Commission, No. 7197, March 2, 1920, in Application No. 3625.

The transfer of the rights and privileges hereinbefore mentioned is to be made in accordance with an agreement, copy of which was filed with the application in this proceeding.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

1-- That the applicants, Phil Dicke, J. P. Hildreth and G. E. Skillicorn, operating under the fictitious name of the Healdsburg and Santa Rosa Auto Freight Company will immediately acknowledge receipt and file their written acceptance of this order.

2-- The rights and privileges of transfer hereby authorized may not again be leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such lease, transfer or assignment has first been secured.

3-- No vehicle may be operated under this authority for transfer by applicants, Phil Dicke, J. P. Hildreth and G.E. Skillicorn, operating under the fictitious name of the Healdsburg and Santa Rosa Auto Freight Company unless such vehicle is owned by such applicants or is leased by them under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
