O R D E R

V. H. Morris has made application to the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the operation of passenger automobile stage service between Dunsmuir and Weed, California. There is no passenger stage service between Dunsmuir and Weed at the present time, and the Southern Pacific Company operates but one train, each way, a day.

The Southern Pacific Company has advised the Commission that it will not oppose this application.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that public convenience and necessity require the establishment of an automobile passenger stage service between Dunsmuir and Weed and that a certificate of public convenience and necessity be granted and the same hereby is granted to the applicant, V. H. Morris, subject to the following conditions:

1-- That the applicant, V. H. Morris, will, within ten (10) days from the issuance of this order, file a written acceptance

of this certificate and the conditions set forth herein and will within thirty (30) days commence operation of the service requested.

2-- That the applicant, V. H. Morris, will be required to immediately file tariff and time schedule with the Railroad Commission in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.

3-- The rights and privileges which are hereby authorized may not again be leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such lease, transfer or assignment has first been secured.

4-- No vehicle may be operated under this authority by the applicant, V. H. Morris, unless such vehicle is owned by such applicant or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
