ORDER

Pittsburg Water Company having applied to the Railroad Commission for authority to sell its water system to the City of Pittsburg in accordance with the terms of a proposed agreement of sale entered into by and between the Pittsburg Water Company and the City of Pittsburg, copy of which agreement is attached to the application herein and marked "Exhibit A" and hereby referred to and made a part hereof; and it appearing that public interest will be served by this transfer and that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be and it is hereby granted, on the following conditions:

1. The consideration given for the transfer of said public utility water system shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value of said properties for rate fixing or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

2. The authority herein granted to transfer said water

system shall apply only to such transfer as may have been made on or before September 1, 1920, and a certified copy of the instrument of conveyance transferring the property herein authorized to be transferred shall be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days of the date on which it is executed.

3. Within ten (10) days of the time when Pittsburg Water Company actually relinquishes possession and control of the properties herein authorized to be transferred, said company shall file a statement in writing with the Commission indicating the date of such transfer.
