O R D E R

Hayward Water Company is a public utility water company engaged in the business of supplying water for domestic and irrigation purposes in the town of Hayward and vicinity. In the above entitled proceeding applicant asks for authority to sell its public utility water property, more particularly described in the application and hereby referred to and made a part hereof, to the town of Hayward. The town of Hayward has joined in said proceeding and requests that the application be granted; and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be, and the same is hereby granted, on the following conditions:

1. The consideration given for the transfer of said public utility water system shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value of said properties for rate fixing or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.
2. The authority herein granted to transfer said water

system and properties shall apply only to such transfer as may have been made on or before September 1, 1920, and a certified copy of the instrument of conveyance transferring the properties herein authorized to be transferred shall be filed by Town of Hayward with the Commission within thirty (30) days from the date on which it is executed.

3. Within ten (10) days of the date on which Hayward Water Company actually relinquishes control and possession of the properties herein authorized to be transferred, said company shall file a certified statement with the Commission, indicating the date on which it relinquished control and possession of said properties.
