Pacific Electric Railway Company having, on March 31, 1920, filed an application with the Commission for permission to construct a spur track, at grade, along and upon Riverside Drive, in the City of Long Beach, County of Los Angeles, State of California, as more particularly described in the application and as shown by the map attached thereto; and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary; that the Legislative Body of the City of Long Beach has granted its permission for the construction of said track, at grade; and it further appearing that it is not reasonable nor practicable to avoid a grade crossing with said street, and that this application should be granted subject to the conditions hereinafter specified:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, That permission be and the same is hereby granted Pacific Electric Railway Company to construct a spur track, at grade, along and upon Riverside Drive, in the City of Long Beach, County of Los Angeles,
