FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

The Railroad Commission having by Decision Number 7130, dated February 13, 1920, authorized SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY to issue, at not less than \$90.00 per share, 50,000 shares (\$5,000,000.00) of its common capital stock, subject among others, to the condition that none of the proceeds should be expended except for such purposes as the Railroad Commission might authorize in a supplemental order or orders in this proceeding, and applicant having reported that during the month of February it expended on account of construction of extensions, additions and betterments the sum of \$494,436.51, against which it has issued no stocks or bonds, and that it has obtained from the sale of the stock, -the issue of which is authorized by Decision Number 7130, dated February 13, 1920, the sum of \$82,886.55, and applicant having asked permission to use the \$82,886.55 to pay in part the construction expenditures, to which reference has been made; and it appearing to the Railroad Commission that such expenditures are reasonable and proper and that applicant's request should be granted,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY be, and it is hereby, authorized to expend \$82,886.55 obtained from the sale of stock, the issue of which was authorized by Decision Number 7130, dated February 13, 1920, to finance in part the construction of extensions, additions and betterments during February 1920, and referred to in the First Supplemental Petition in this proceeding.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that the order in Decision Number 7130, dated February 13, 1920, shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this First Supplemental Order.
