BY THE COMMISSION:

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Railroad Commission having by Decision No. 7107, dated February 10, 1920, permitted FRESNO CITY WATER CORPORATION to issue \$250,000.00 of its 6% 40-year bonds, subject among others to the condition that no bonds be issued until the Commission has by supplemental order authorized the execution of a mortgage securing the payment of the bonds, and Fresno City Water Corporation having filed a copy of its proposed mortgage and deed of trust marked "Exhibit "A" of Supplement to Application No. 5209"; and such mortgage and deed of trust appearing to be in satisfactory form;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that FRESNO CITY WATER CORPORATION be, and it is hereby, granted authority to execute a mortgage and deed of trust substantially in the same form as the mortgage and deed of trust filed in this proceeding on April 14, 1920, and marked "Exhibit "A" of Supplement to Application No. 5209";-

PROVIDED, that the approval herein given of said mortgage and deed of trust is for the purpose of this proceeding only and an approval in so far as this Com-

mission has jurisdiction under the terms of the Public Utilities Act, and is not intended as an approval of said mortgage and deed of trust as to such other legal requirements to which said mortgage and deed of trust may be subject; and

PROVIDED FURTHER, that the authority herein granted will not be interpreted as imposing upon the Commission any obligation whatsoever to authorize the issue of any additional bonds under said mortgage and deed of trust pursuant to the terms and conditions thereof.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that the order in Decision No. 7109 dated February 10, 1920, shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this First Supplemental Order.
