O R D E R

The Western Auto Stage Company, Inc., and W. D. Greer have petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order approving the sale and transfer of certain operative rights for the conduct of an automobile passenger service between the city of Taft, the city of San Luis Obispo and Pismo Beach, the applicant, Western Auto Stage Company, Inc., a corporation, desiring to sell and W. D. Greer desiring to purchase, acquire and hereafter operate said auto passenger service.

The rights and privileges proposed to be transferred are those acquired by the applicant, Western Auto Stage Company, Inc., a corporation, by virtue of having operated in good faith prior to May 1, 1917 and having operated the line continuously since that date.

The transfer of the rights and privileges is to be made in accordance with an agreement accompanying and filed with the application in this proceeding.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

1- That the applicants, Western Auto Stage Company, Inc., a corporation, and W. D. Greer will, within twenty (20) days from the date of service hereof, file in writing an acceptance of this order and the conditions contained herein.

2- The applicant, Western Auto Stage Company, Inc., a corporation, will be required to immediately cancel all tariffs and time schedules now on file with the Railroad Commission, such cancellations to be made in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.

3- Applicant, W. D. Greer, will be required to file tariffs and time schedules in his own name, or to adopt as his own the tariffs and time schedules heretofore filed by Western Auto Stage Company, Inc., a corporation, all rates to be identical with those heretofore filed with the Railroad Commission by applicant, Western Auto Stage Company, Inc., a corporation, such tariffs and time schedules, or adoption thereof to be made in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.

4- The rights and privileges of transfer which are hereby authorized may not again be leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such transfer, lease or assignment has first been secured.

5- No vehicle may be operated under this authority for transfer

by applicant. W. D. Greer, unless such certificate is owned by him or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
