ORDER

George Grant Cuddeback has made application petitioning the Railroad Commission to issue a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the establishment of auto passenger and freight stage service between Bridgeville and Ruth, California.

There is now no authorized stage or truck line, steam or electric railroads operating between the points to be served. There is no method of transportation for persons or property except private conveyances. The establishment of such service would no doubt be a great convenience to the public.

The Railroad Commission is of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED, that public convenience and necessity require the establishment of an auto, freight and passenger service between Bridgeville, Humboldt County, and Ruth, Trinity County, California and that a certificate of public convenience and necessity be, and the same is hereby granted subject to the following conditions:

1 - That applicant, George G. Cuddeback will within 20 days from the date of the service of this order file with the Railroad Commission a written acceptance of this certificate and the conditions set forth herein, and will commence this service within 90 days from the date hereof.

2- That applicant, Cuddeback will immediately file with the Railroad Commission tariffs and time schedules in accordance with the provisions of General Order No.51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.

3- The rights and privileges hereby authorized may not be leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such lease, transfer or assignment has first been secured.

4- No vehicle may be operated by applicant Cuddeback unless such vehicle is owned by him or is leased by him under contract or agreement satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
