ORDER

A. R. Peddar, being the owner of a small domestic water system supplying the inhabitants of the Bower's Addition to the town of Davisville, Yolo County, having asked authority to transfer to the City of Davis all of said water system more particularly described in the application, and the City of Davis having joined in the application and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be, and it is hereby granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. The authority herein granted to transfer said water system shall apply only to such transfer as may have been made on or before September 30; 1920, and a certified copy of the instrument of conveyance transferring the properties herein authorized to be transferred shall be filed by A. R. Pedder with the Railroad Commission within thirty (30) days after the date on which it is executed.

2. Within ten (10) days from the time when A. R. Pedder

actually relinquishes possession and control of the properties herein authorized to be transferred, he shall file a certified statement with the Commission indicating the date on which he relinquished such possession and control.
