FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Condition No. 3 of the Order in Decision No. 7438, dated April 19, 1920, and being the condition requiring the setting aside of a depreciation fund, be and the same is hereby amended so as to require the first monthly installment of \$3,750 to be set aside three months from the effective date of the new telephone rate schedule.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Order in Decision No. 7438 remain in full force and effect except as modified by this First Supplemental Order.
