O R D E R

Edmond Wilkinson has made application petitioning the Railroad Commission for certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an automotive passenger and freight service between Bridgeville and Alder Point, both in Humboldt County, California. There is now no means of transportation of persons or property between the points proposed to be served except private conveyances and those desiring to travel or ship property between Bridgeville and Alder Point will be greatly inconvenienced by the establishment of such a service, for which a real public necessity exists.

The Commission is of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that public convenience and necessity require the establishment by Edmond Wilkinson of automotive passenger and freight service between Bridgeville and Alder Point and that a certificate of public convenience and necessity should be and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

1- That applicant, Edmond Wilkinson, will, within twenty (20) days from the date hereof, file with the Railroad Commission his written acceptance of this certificate and the conditions named herein, and that said applicant will commence this service within ninety (90) days from the date hereof.

2- That applicant, Edmond Wilkinson, will be required to immediately file tariff of fares, rates, charges and time schedule with the Railroad Commission in accordance with provisions of General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.

3- That the operative rights and privileges, authority for which are hereby granted may not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such discontinuance, sale, lease, transfer or assignment has first been secured.

4- No vehicle may be operated by applicant, Edmond Wilkinson, unless such vehicle is owned by him or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
