O R D E R

C. E. Sansome, now operating automotive passenger stage service between Taft-Hayes Lease, Section 36 Elk Hills, has made application petitioning the Railroad Commission for certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an automobile passenger stage service between Hayes Lease and Tuttmann Lease, Section 36 Elk Hills.

There is no means of transportation for passengers between the points proposed to be served except private conveyances and a real necessity for the service exists and will be a great convenience to the public.

The Commission is of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that public convenience and necessity require that C. E. Sansome establish automotive passenger stage service between Hayes Lease and Tuttmann Lease, Section 36 Elk Hills, California, and certificate of public convenience and necessity

should be and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

1- Applicant, C.E. Sansome, will within twenty (20) days from the date of this order file with the Railroad Commission a written acceptance of this certificate and the conditions contained herein and that operation of the service will commence within ninety (90) days from the date of service hereof.

2- Applicant, C. E. Sansome, will be required to immediately file tariff of rates, fares, charges and a time schedule in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.

3- The rights and privileges hereby authorized may not be discontinued, sold, transferred, leased nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such discontinuance, sale, transfer, lease or assignment has first been secured.

4- No vehicle may be operated by the applicant, C. E. Sansome, unless such vehicle is owned by such applicant or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
