ORDER

Mary M. Bradbury and E. L. Doherty having joined in the above entitled application for authority to transfer certain public utility water property, and it appearing that E. L. Doherty, who desires to purchase said property, is now engaged in the business of supplying water in the towns of Larkspur and Corte Madera, and that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be and the same is hereby granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. The consideration given for the transfer of said public utility water property shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value of said properties for rate fixing or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.
2. The authority herein granted to transfer said water system shall apply only to such transfer as may have been made on or before September 1, 1920, and a certified copy of the instrument of conveyance shall be filed with the Commission by E. L. Doherty within thirty (30) days of the date on which it is executed.
3. Within ten days of the date on which Mary M. Bradbury actually relinquishes control and possession of the properties herein authorized to be transferred, she shall file with the

Railroad Commission a certified statement indicating the date on which she relinquished such control and possession.
