ORDER

HOWARD COMPANY, a public utility, operating warehouses in the City of Oakland, having applied, under sections 15 and 63 of the Public Utilities Act, for authority to place in effect on five days' notice rates, rules and regulations set forth in Exhibit "A" accompanying the application, such rates being in some instances increases over rates at present in effect; and having stated that all its patrons have been apprised of the proposed increases and changes and that none of said patrons have expressed any opposition thereto; and having affirmed that said rates are in all respects reasonable and will not yield applicant more than a fair return for the services performed; and

It appearing to the Reilroad Commission that a public hearing in the above entitled matter is not necessary, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the application be and the same is hereby granted.
