shall be expended by Bakersfield Water Works for the following  
purposes:-

For 962 ft. 8" cast iron pipe, about . . . . .	\$2,232.00
For 7,670 ft. 4" cast iron pipe, about . . . . .	10,508.00
For cast iron fittings and valves, about . . . . .	300.00
For new pump from Byron Jackson Iron Works, about . . . . .	960.00
For finishing part of reservoir to add 500,000 gallons storage, about . . . . .	4,000.00
To pay advance by C. W. Kellogg for new cast iron main . . . . .	<u>2,000.00</u>

Total . . . . . \$20,000.00
