FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that CALIFORNIA WHARF AND WAREHOUSE COMPANY has filed a stipulation, as provided in the order heretofore made in this proceeding, on February 5, 1920, which stipulation states that neither said company, its successors nor assigns will claim before the Railroad Commission, or any court or other public body, a value for the wharf franchise in excess of the amount actually paid by said corporation to the County of Contra Costa as a consideration for the grant of said franchise and that said California Wharf and Warehouse Company has not paid to the County of Contra Costa any consideration whatever for the grant of said franchise.
