In the Matter of the Application of the Humboldt Northern Railway Company for permission to construct an overhead crossing over the right of way and tracks of the Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company at Fieldbrook, Humboldt County, State of California.

## ORDER

The Humboldt Northern Railway Company, a corporation; having, on May 15, 1920, filed with the Commission an application for permission to construct an overhead crossing over the tracks of the Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company near engineer station 181+11, between Fieldbrook and Little River Junction, as hereinafter indicated, and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary; that the Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company has granted applicant permission to make this overhead crossing and has entered into an agreement with applicant, which agreement specifies that the applicant is to pay for the construction and maintenance of this overhead crossing; and it further appearing that this if not a case in which a public hearing is necessary and that this applicant should be granted subject to the conditions hereinafter specified;

IT IS HEREEY ORDERED, That the Eumboldt Northorn Railway Company be and the same is hereby granted permission to construct an overhead-crossing over the tracks of the Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company near engineer station 181+11, between Fieldbrook and Little River Junction as more particularly described in the application and as shown by the map accompanying same, and to be constructed subject to the following conditions, viz:

- (1) The expense of constructing the crossing shall be in accordance with the agreement between the Humboldt Northern Railway Company and the Northwestern Paclific Railroad Company, as previously mentioned.
- (2) All clearances shall be in accordance with those specified in the Commission's General Order No. 26.
- (3) The Commission reserves the right to make such further orders relative to the location, construction, operation, maintenance and protection of said crossing as to it may seem right and proper, and to revoke its permission if, in its judgment the public convenience and necessity demand such action.
