BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Kenneth Fraser has made application petitioning the Railroad Commission for certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an automotive passenger, freight and baggage service between Pasadena - Oak Wilde Camp and intermediate points. There is no other means of transportation of persons or property between the points proposed except private conveyances, which establishes the fact that public convenience and necessity would be well served by the establishment of this service.

The Commission is of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that public convenience and necessity require Kenneth Fraser to establish automotive passenger, freight and baggage service between Pasadena and Oak Wilde Camp in the Arroyo Seco, both in Los Angeles County, California, and intermediate points, and that certificate of public convenience and necessity should be and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

1- That the applicant, Kenneth Fraser, will file with the Railroad Commission a written acceptance of this certificate within twenty (20) days from the date of service hereof and that operation of such service will commence within nineth (90) days from the date of service hereof.

2- That the applicant, Kenneth Fraser, will be required to immediately file a tariff of rates, rules and regulations and a time schedule in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.

3- That the rights and privileges hereby authorized may not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such discontinuance, sale, lease, transfer or assignment has first been secured.

4- That no vehicle may be operated by the applicant, Kenneth Fraser, unless such vehicle is owned by said applicant or is leased by him on a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
