O R D E R

Chas. A. Tyler and C. W. Lewis have petitioned the Railroad Commission for authority to transfer certain operative rights and privileges for the conduct of an automotive freight service between Etna Mills, Callahan, Gazelle and intermediate points, the applicant, Chas. A. Tyler desiring to sell and Applicant, C. W. Lewis, desiring to purchase, acquire and operate said stage service.

The rights and privileges sought to be transferred are those acquired by applicant, Chas. A. Tyler, by virtue of his having operated said service prior to May 1, 1917 and in good faith having continuously operated since that date. The rights and privileges are to be disposed of in accordance with an agreement included in the application in this proceeding.

The Commission is of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application should be and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

1- That the applicants, Chas. A. Tyler and C. W. Lewis, will immediately file with the Railroad Commission the original or a certified copy of the bill of sale.

2- That the applicant, Chas. A. Tyler, will be required to immediately cancel all tariffs and time schedules on file with the Railroad Commission, in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.

3- That the applicant, C. W. Lewis, will be required to file tariff and time schedule in his own name, or to adopt the tariffs and time schedules as heretofore filed by applicant, Chas. A. Tyler, all rates to be identical with those filed with the Railroad Commission by applicant, Chas. A. Tyler.

4- The rights and privileges of transfer which are hereby authorized may not again be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such discontinuance, sale, lease, transfer or assignment has first been secured.

5- No vehicle may be operated under this authority for transfer by applicant, C. W. Lewis, unless such vehicle is owned by him or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
