BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

J. T. Gibbins and Walter Gosney have made application to the Railroad Commission petitioning for authority to transfer certain operative rights and privileges for the conduct of an automotive passenger service between Westwood, Lassen County and Paynes Creek, Tehama County, the applicant, Gibbins, desiring to sell and applicant, Gosney, desiring to purchase, acquire and hereafter operate said service.

The rights and privileges, transfer of which are hereby authorized, were acquired by applicant, Gibbins, by declaration of public convenience and necessity in Decision No. 5714, Application No. 3896, rendered August 26, 1918. A certified statement of the sale of such rights and privileges by Gibbins to Gosney is filed with the application in this proceeding.

The Commission is of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same heroby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

1- That the applicants, J. T. Gibbins and Walter Gosney, will immediately file with the Railroad Commission the original or a certified copy of the bill of sale.

2- That the applicant, J. T. Gibbins, will be required to immediately cancel his tariff of rates, fares and charges and time schedule on file with the Railroad Commission, in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.

3- That the applicant, Walter Gosney, will be required to file tariff of rates, fares and charges and time schedule in his own name, or to adopt as his own the tariff and time schedule as heretofore filed by applicant, J. T. Gibbins, all rates, fares, charges and time schedule to be identical with those file by applicant, J. T. Gibbins.

4- The rights and privileges of transfer heroby authorized may not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such discontinuance, sale, lease, transfer or assignment has first been secured.

5- No vehicle may be operated under this authority for transfer by applicant, Walter Gosney, unless such vehicle is owned by him or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
