O P I N I O N

Applicant herein requests authority to establish rates for storing and handling cotton at Imperial.

A public hearing upon the application was held by Examiner Westover at El Centro.

This proceeding involves similar features to that of application of Calexico Compress Company, No. 5397. Both companies are engaged in storing and handling cotton in Imperial Valley. They are under the same management; their rates, rules and regulations are the same and their operating expenses are of a similar nature. The two applications were heard together and the same testimony, in so far as germane, was offered in support of each. For

further details reference is hereby made to decision upon Application No. 5397. The testimony justifies granting the application for authority to maintain the schedule now in effect, set forth as Exhibit "D" in the application.

O R D E R

Imperial Compress Company having applied to the Railroad Commission for authority to establish rates for storing and handling cotton as set out in Exhibit D accompanying the application, a public hearing having been held thereon, the matter having been submitted and being now ready for decision,

IT IS HEREBY FOUND AS A FACT that the schedule of rates proposed is just and reasonable for the service involved.

Pasing its order upon the foregoing finding of fact and upon the facts set forth in the opinion preceding this order,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Railroad Commission that Imperial Compress Company be and it is hereby authorized to file with the Commission within 20 days from date hereof and thereafter charge and collect the rates and charges for storing and handling cotton at Calexico, which are set forth in Exhibit D attached to and made part of the application herein.
