SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY, having reported in its second supplemental petition in the above entitled matter that it has on deposit in a special fund the sum of \$153,830.71 obtained from the sale of stock, the issue and sale of which the Commission has heretofore authorized; that it has expended for new construction and the acquisition of properties the sum of \$210,827.85; that the \$210,827.85 represents uncapitalized capital expenditures, and therefore it asks permission to use the \$153,830.71 to reimburse itself in part on account of the said expenditures of \$210,827.85, and the Commission being of the opinion that applicant's request should be granted as herein provided;

NOW WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY be, and it is hereby, authorized to use the \$153,830.71 obtained from the sale of stock to reimburse its treasury or pay indebtedness, to finance in part the \$210,827.85 of uncapitalized expenditures reported in the second supplemental peti-

tion in the above entitled matter.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that the orders heretofore made in Applications No. 2743, No. 4790 and No. 5312, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this second supplemental order.
