ORDER

D. A. Hedger, George A. Hedger, J. A. Hedger, B. F. Hedger, Ina M. Wells, Clara Sciferlie, Ada Hedger and Roy Hedger, joint owners, operating a small telephone system in Live Oak, Sutter County, California, having asked authority to sell their system to The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company for the sum of One Hundred Fifteen Dollars (\$115.00), in accordance with the form of Instrument of Transfer attached to the application herein as Exhibit "A", the property to be transferred being described as follows:

- 4 magneto desk telephones, and
- 5 magneto wall telephones complete with subscriber's set, transmitter and receiver,
- 150 feet of twisted #14 iron covered wire,
- 1200 feet of #14 bare iron wire, metallic line,
- 2 1/2 miles of #14 bare iron wire, metallic line,
- 1/2 mile of #14 bare iron wire, grounded line,
- 13 small poles, approximately 2 x 4 x 10 feet,
- 9-4 x 6 - 14 feet square redwood poles.

And it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the application herein be, and the same hereby is, granted; provided that the consideration given for the property authorized to be transferred shall not be taken before this Commission or any other public body as representing for rate fixing or other purposes the value of the property transferred; and, provided further, that the authority herein granted to transfer shall apply only to such transfer as is made on or before July 31, 1920.
