APPLICATION NO. 5791.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

R. E. Williams and R. B. Cregar have made application to the Railroad Commission petitioning for authority to sell and transfer certain operative rights for the conduct of an automotive passenger service between San Jacinto and Idlewild and intermediate points, the applicant, R.E.Williams, desiring to sell and the applicant, R.B.Cregar desiring to purchase, acquire and hereafter operate said service. The rights and privileges herein sought to be transferred are those acquired by applicant, R.E.Williams, by reason of this Commission's Decision No. 4921 December 4, 1917, on Application No. 3355.

The transfer of the rights and privileges herein authorized is to be made in accordance with an agreement contained in the application in this proceeding.

The Commission is of the opinion that this is a matter in

which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application should be and the same hereby is granted. subject to the following conditions:

1- That the applicants, R. E. Williams and R. B. Cregar, will immediately file with the Railroad Commission the original or a certified copy of the bill of sale, in detail.

2- That applicant, R. E. Williams, will be required to immediately cancel his tariff and time schedule on file with the Railroad Commission, in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.

3- That applicant, R.B.Cregar, will be required to file tariff and time schedule in his own name, or to adopt the tariff and time schedule as heretofore filed by applicant R.E.Williams, all rates to be identical with those filed with the Railroad Commission by said applicant, R.E.Williams.

4- The rights and privileges, transfer of which are hereby authorized may not again be transferred or assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such transfer or assignment has first been secured.

5- No vehicle may be operated under this authority for transfer by applicant unless such vehicle is owned by him or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
