BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

W. W. Van Deusen and Elmer Donlay have made application to the Railroad Commission to sell and transfer certain operative rights for the conduct of an automotive milk freight truck service between Los Angeles, Downey, Clearwater, Hynes and intermediate points, the applicant, Van Deusen desiring to sell and the applicant Donlay desiring to purchase, acquire and hereafter operate said service.

The operative rights herein sought to transfer are those acquired by the applicant, W. W. Van Deusen, under this Commission's Decision No. 7695 of June 8, 1920. in Application No. 4636. The transfer of the rights and privileges herein sought is to be made in accordance with agreement set forth in application.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter on which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be

granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

1st- That the original or a certified copy of the bill of sale, in detail, be immediately filed with the Railroad Commission.

2nd- That the applicant, W. W. Van Deusen, will be required to immediately cancel all tariffs and time schedules on file with the Railroad Commission, in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.

3rd- That the applicant, Elmer Donlay, will be required to file, in duplicate, tariff and time schedule in his own name or to adopt the tariff and time schedule as heretofore filed by applicant W. W. Van Deusen, all rates and charges to be identical with those filed with the Railroad Commission by said applicant, W. W. Van Deusen.

4th- The rights and privileges of transfer hereby authorized may not again be transferred, assigned, discontinued, sold nor leased unless such transfer, assignment, discontinuance, sale or lease has been authorized by the written consent of the Railroad Commission.

5th- No vehicle may be operated under this authority for transfer by applicant, Elmer Donlay, unless such vehicle is owned by him or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
