San Joaquin and Eastern Railroad Company, a corporation, operating a standard gauge railroad between the stations of El Prado and Cascada all in Fresno County, has applied to the Railroad Commission for authority to abandon the station of Shipp located 4.9 miles from El Prado for the reason that, during the past twelve months, no passengers have offered for transportation nor has any freight, either carload or less than carload, been forwarded to or received at such station and that the only persons who would in any wise be affected by the abandonment of the proposed station are willing that such abandonment be made.

The matter having been given investigation and the Commission being fully advised and of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same hereby is granted.
