BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Sarop Meketaroff and Bob Arutoff have made application to the Railroad Commission petitioning for authority to sell and transfer certain operative rights for the conduct of an auto truck milk route between Los Angeles, Gardena and Moneta and intermediate points, known as the WEST SIDE route, the applicant, Sarop Meketaroff, desiring to sell and the applicant, Bob Arutoff, desiring to purchase, acquire and hereafter operate said service.

The operative rights herein sought to transfer are those acquired by applicant, Sarop Meketaroff, by reason of this Commission's Decision No. 7431, April 15, 1920, in Application No. 5501.

The transfer of such operative rights is to be made in accordance with an agreement set forth in the application in this proceeding.

The Commission is of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application should be and the same is hereby granted, subject to the following conditions:

1st- That the original or a certified copy of the bill of sale, in detail, be immediately filed with the Railroad Commission.

2nd- That the applicant, Sarop Meketaroff, will be required to immediately cancel his tariff and time schedule on file with the Railroad Commission, in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.

3rd- That the applicant, Bob Arutoff, will be required to file tariff and time schedule, in duplicate, or to adopt the tariff and time schedule heretofore filed by applicant, Sarop Meketaroff, all rates, and charges to be identical with those filed with the Railroad Commission by said applicant, Sarop Meketaroff.

4th- The rights and privileges of transfer which are hereby authorized may not again be transferred, discontinued, sold, leased nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such transfer, discontinuance, sale, lease or assignment has first been secured.

5th- No vehicle may be operated under this authority

for transfer by applicant, Bob Arutoff, unless such vehicle is owned by him or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
