SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In establishing the rates to be charged for electric service by Pacific Gas and Electric Company in Decision No. 7823, dated June 30, 1920, in the above entitled proceeding, provision was not made for rates to be charged for direct current service where supplied except in the City and County of San Francisco. The order herein fixes just and reasonable rates for this service.

It further appears that the rates for metered service for electricity supplied in the town of Roseville by Pacific Gas and Electric Company superseding flat rates formerly in effect cannot be immediately effective until meters shall be installed for the measurement of electricity. The order herein will therefore provide for the continuation of the existing flat rates of Pacific Gas and Electric Company in the town of Roseville for a period of ninety days pending the installation of meters.

O R D E R

Based on the foregoing considerations,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Schedule P-1 as set forth in the Order in Decision No. 7823 be and the same is hereby revised and amended to read as follows:

SCHEDULE P-1

(Cancels schedules of former Pacific Gas and Electric System Nos. 112, 120, 121, 133, 137, 142, 143, 143-X, 144, 146, 156, 157, 157-X, 162, 163, 171, 175, 203, 209.)

General Commercial and Industrial Power Service:

Applicable to Alternating Current Power Service, except as provided under Special Conditions for Direct Current Service.

Territory:

Applicable to entire former Pacific Gas and Electric Company's system.

Minimum Charge:

a. Connected Load Basis

\$1.00 per month per horsepower of active connected load for the first 50 horsepower plus \$0.60 per month per horsepower for each horsepower of load in excess of 50 horsepower, but not less than \$2.00 per month.

b. Maximum Demand Basis

\$1.00 per month per horsepower of measured maximum demand which shall not be less than 20% of the total active connected load, and in no case less than \$50.00 per month.

Special Conditions:

- a. Direct Current Service. If the company elects to supply direct current the charges for direct current service shall be in accordance with the above rates and minimums.

If the consumer elects to use direct current when both direct and alternating current service are available the charges for direct current service shall be 10% in addition to the above rates and minimums.

- b. Maximum Demand. Consumers having a total connected load in excess of 50 horsepower consisting of two or more motors may, upon request, have the rate and minimum based on the maximum demand, which is defined as the greatest average horsepower demand registered during any 15 minute interval during the month; except that for service to intermittent loads, such as elevators, hoists, etc. the interval of registration may be 3 minutes instead of 15 minutes.

- c. Option of Rate for Larger Installation. Any consumer may obtain the rates for a larger installation by guaranteeing the rates and minimums applicable to the larger installation.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company be and it is hereby authorized to continue in effect for a period of ninety days from the date of the original order herein its schedule No. 139, being C.R.C. Original Sheet No. 38-E, for flat rate service in the town of Roseville, to proceed with the installation of meters, and upon their installation to charge in accordance with the metered rates as established

in Decision No. 7823.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the surcharge of 15% authorized in Decision No. 7823 shall apply to the rates hereinabove established, and both the above rates and surcharge shall apply to service rendered in accordance with the effective dates of Decision No. 7823 herein.

PROVIDED, Pacific Gas and Electric Company shall within ten days of the date of this order file with the Railroad Commission the schedules of rates herein established.
