O R D E R

CAPAY WAREHOUSE ASSOCIATION having applied to the Railroad Commission for authority to increase rates for storing grain at Capay, basing such request primarily upon the showing that the cost of warehouse labor is $66\frac{2}{3}$ per cent higher than when the present storage rates were established; having shown by its ^{annual} reports on file with the Commission for the years 1916 to 1919 inclusive, an average annual net income of only \$221.08 for distribution among members of the association, and it appearing to the Commission that a public hearing is not necessary in this case;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Railroad Commission of the State of California, that Capay Warehouse Association be, and the same is hereby, authorized to publish and file immediately and thereafter collect, rates for warehouse ser-

vice at Capay in accordance with the following:
