BY THE COMMISSION.

O R D E R

STATE WAREHOUSE COMPANY having applied to this Commission for authority to increase rates for the storage of grain at Salinas and to establish a schedule of rates for storing other commodities; having shown by statements filed with the application an operating loss of \$95.73 for the year ending December 31, 1919; rates sought being identical with rates authorized by the Commission in Decision No. 7776, dated June 8, 1920, applicable at Salinas and other points in the same locality; and it appearing to the Commission that in this instance a public hearing is not necessary;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that State Warehouse Company be, and the same is hereby, authorized to publish and file

immediately and thereafter collect rates as set forth in the following:

GRAIN:

Storing - 1 month, per ton,	\$.75
2 months " "	1.00
Season ending May 31,	1.25

HONEY, DRIED AND GREEN FRUITS:

Storing - 1 month, per ton	1.25
2 months " "	1.50
Season ending May 31,	1.75

POTATOES AND ONIONS:

Storing - 1 month, per ton	1.25
2 months " "	1.75
Season ending May 31,	2.00
