O R D E R

Intrastate Warehouse Company, having applied to this Commission for authority to increase warehouse rates at Lancaster, citing in support thereof the recent well known advances in the cost of warehouse labor; and it appearing to the Commission that the proposed rates are not unreasonably high nor in excess of rates charged for similar service by other public warehousemen; and it appearing further that in this instance a public hearing is not necessary;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Railroad Commission of the State of California that Intrastate Warehouse Company be, and the same is, hereby authorized to publish and file,

immediately and thereafter collect for warehouse service
at Lancaster, rates in accordance with the following:
