BY THE COMMISSION.

O R D E R

LOS MOLINOS WAREHOUSE, a public utility having applied to the Railroad Commission for authority to increase rates for storing and handling hay at Los Molinos, such application being based upon the alleged "large advance in the cost of labor;" the rates proposed appearing not to be unjust or unreasonable nor in excess of rates charged for similar service at other warehouses; recent increased cost of warehouse labor being well-known to the Commission; and it appearing that this is a matter which does not require a public hearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Railroad Commission of the State of California that Los Molinos Warehouse, a public utility owned and managed by C. A. Covert, be, and the same is

hereby authorized to publish and file, immediately and thereafter collect, rates for storing and handling hay at Los Malinos in accordance with the following:
