ORDER

J. H. Brothers, a public warehouse utility, having applied to the Railroad Commission for authority to increase rates for storing and handling grain at Stratford alleging heavy increase in the cost of warehouse labor; having shown by verified statement an operating deficit of \$1,447.77 for the 1919-20 season; the Commission having authorized the same rates for similar service at another warehouse located at Stratford, (See Decision No. 7885), and it appearing that in this instance a public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that J. H. Brothers be, and he is hereby authorized to publish and file immediately and there-

after collect rates for storing and handling grain at Stratford
