ORDER

Benjamin R. Day and Bessie Phillips Day having made application in the above entitled proceeding asking permission to increase rates for water supplied for domestic and irrigation use at Harpersville, Orange County; and it appearing that applicants serve only one public utility consumer and that service to this consumer will be discontinued on or before December 31, 1920, in accordance with this Commission's order in Decision No. 7504; and it further appearing that the rates desired by applicants are reasonable in view of the increases in the cost of labor, material and electric power, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Benjamin R. Day and Bessie Phillips Day be and the same are hereby authorized and directed to file with the Railroad Commission, within ten days from the date of this order and thereafter charge, the following rates for water

delivered to its public utility consumer:

Domestic use, a flat rate of \$1.50 per month.

Irrigation use, \$0.75 per hour of run of pump.
