ORDER.

Applicants in the above entitled proceeding having asked permission of the Commission to place meters upon services of consumers of water in Angels Camp, Murpheys, Vallecito and Altaville, Calaveras County; and having asked that meter rates be established for such service; and having stated that they do not seek through this application an increase in revenue from the sale of water, but that they desire such meter rates be established as will yield them the same net revenue as is derived from the existing flat rates, and that the metering of services and the establishment of meter rates is desired to prevent excessive waster of water by domestic and industrial users and to permit the use of water so conserved for the purposes of electric power production; and it appearing that this is a proceeding in which a hearing is not necessary,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Emma H. Rose, Anna G. Lane and Hobart Estate Company, a corporation, be and the same are hereby authorized to file with this Commission within ten (10) days from the date of this order and thereafter charge the following rates for water

delivered to their consumers:

Monthly Minimum Charges:

For 5/8 inch meters,	\$1.25
For 3/4 inch meters,	1.50
For 1 inch meters,	2.00
For 1 1/2 inch meters,	2.50
For 2 inch meters,	3.00
For 3 inch meters, and larger,	4.00

Monthly Meter Rates:

From 0 to 500 cubic feet, per 100 cu. ft.,	\$0.25
From 500 to 2000 " " " " " "	0.20
Over 2000 " " " " " "	0.15

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the authorization to establish the above schedule of rates is expressly conditioned upon applicant's holding as a trust fund any sum derived from the rates established herein over and above the sum which would be produced by the flat rates heretofore in effect. Such overplus, if any, shall at all times be held at the disposition of this Commission for the benefit of the consumers.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED THAT Emma H. Rose, Anna G. Lane and Hobart Estate Company, a corporation, be and the same are hereby directed to file with this Commission every sixty days (60) beginning September 1st, 1920, a statement setting out fully and in detail the results of the application of the rates herein established and the revenue which would have been yielded by the flat rates heretofore in effect.
