## ORDER

Ene Los Angeles-San Pedro Transportation Company, Inc., a corporation, has made application petitioning the Railroad Commission for authority to operate its line over the new Boulevard between Los Angeles and the harbor district at Vilmington and San Pedro via Alameda Street and an extension thereof to the harbor district. The City and County of Los Angeles is constructing a new concrete boulevard which is an extension of Alameda Street. The applicant believes it is the purpose to route motor truck traffic over the new Alameda Street Boulevard and makes application to the Commission to operate over this new boulevard in addition to his present route.

The Commission believes this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

In IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application should be and the same is hereby granted, and that the applicant, Los ingoles-San Pedro Transportation Company. Inc., a corporation, will within twenty (20) days from the date hereof file with the Railroad Commission a written acceptance of this order.
