ORDER

The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company having ap-
plied to the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing it to
sell to Shelley Inch its telephone exchange property located in
the City of Placerville, California, and authorizing Shelley Inch
to acquire the same for the sum of Four Thousand (4000.00) Dol-
lars, in accordance with the terms of a certain lease dated March
1, 1912, attached to the application as Exhibit "A", and a cer-
tain agreement dated March 20, 1912, attached to the application
as Exhibit "B"; the property to be transferred being described
therein as follows:
