BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

W. E. Gillen and Joseph Miller have made application to the Railroad Commission for authority to sell and transfer certain operative rights for the conduct of an automotive stage service between Visalia and Dinuba and intermediate points, the applicant, W. E. Gillen, operating under the fictitious name of Visalia-Dinuba Stage Line, desiring to sell, and Joseph Miller, desiring to purchase, acquire and hereafter operate said service.

The operative rights, transfer of which are herein sought, are those acquired by the applicant, W. E. Gillen, under this Commission's Decision No. 6953, December 17, 1919, on Application No. 5086.

The Commission is of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same is hereby granted, subject to the following conditions:

1st- That the applicants, W. E. Gillen and Joseph Miller, will within twenty (20) days from the date hereof file with the Railroad Commission a written acceptance of the order in this proceeding, subject to the conditions imposed herein.

2nd- That the applicant, W. E. Gillen, will be required to cancel his tariff of fares and time schedule, on file with the Railroad Commission, in accordance with General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.

3rd- That the applicant, Joseph Miller, will be required to immediately file with the Railroad Commission his tariff of fares and a time schedule, or will adopt as his own the tariff and time schedule heretofore filed by applicant, W.E.Gillen, such fares, charges and time schedule to be identical with those heretofore filed by the applicant, W. E. Gillen.

4th- The rights and privileges of transfer hereby authorized may not again be sold, leased, transferred, discontinued nor assigned, unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such sale, lease, transfer, discontinuance or assignment has first been secured.

5th- No vehicle may be operated under this authority for transfer by applicant, Joseph Miller, unless such vehicle is owned by him or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
