In the Matter of the Application of Riel Dani for permission to Sell and transfer his Stage 1116 operating between King City and Jolon to George Thompson.

## <u>O R D E R</u>

Riel Dani and George Thompson have petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order approving the sale and transfer of certain operative rights for the conduct of an automotive stage line between King City and Jolon, and intermediate points, California, the applicant, Riel Dani desiring to sell, and the applicant, George Thompson, desiring to purchase, acquire and hereafter operate said service.

The rights and privileges, transfer of which are hereby sought, are those acquired by the applicant, Riel Dani, by virtue of his having operated such service prior to May 1, 1917 and having continued to operate in good faith since that date.

The Railroad Commission is of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same is hereby granted, subject to the following conditions:

lst- That the applicants, Riel Dani and George Thompson, will, within twenty (20) days from the date hereof file, in writing, with the Railroad Commission, an acceptance of this order and the conditions contained herein.

2nd -- That the applicant, Riel Dani, will be required to

immediately cancel his tariff and time schedule now on file with the Railroad Commission, such cancellations to be made in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.

3rd-- That the applicant, George Thompson, will be required to file tariff and time schedule, in duplicate, in his own mame, or to adopt as his own the tariff and time schedule heretofore filed by the applicant, Riel Dani, such tariff and time schedule to be identical with those heretofore filed with the Railroad Commission by Riel Dani, and in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.

4th-- The rights and privileges of transfer hereby authorized may not again be transferred, sold, leased, discontinued nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such transfer, sale, lease, discontinuance or assignment has first been secured.

5th-- No vehicle may be operated under this authority for transfer by the applicant, George Thompson, unless such vehicle is owned by

him or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
